NSA Prism program taps in to user data of Apple, Google and others

- Top-secret Prism program claims direct access to servers of firms including Google, Apple and Facebook
- Companies deny any knowledge of program in operation since 2007



Microsoft handed the NSA access to encrypted messages

- Secret files show scale of Silicon Valley co-operation on Prism
- Outlook.com encryption unlocked even before official launch
- Skype worked to enable Prism collection of video calls
- Company says it is legally compelled to comply

XKeyscore: NSA tool collects 'nearly everything a user does on the internet'

- XKeyscore gives 'widest-reaching' collection of online data
- NSA analysts require no prior authorization for searches
- Sweeps up emails, social media activity and browsing history
- NSA's XKeyscore program – read one of the presentations

NSA paid millions to cover Prism compliance costs for tech companies

- Top-secret files show first evidence of financial relationships
- Prism companies include Google and Yahoo, says NSA
- Costs were incurred after 2011 Fisa court ruling

NSA shares raw intelligence including Americans' data with Israel

- Secret deal places no legal limits on use of data by Israelis
- Only official US government communications protected
- Agency insists it complies with rules governing privacy

Revealed: how US and UK spy agencies defeat internet privacy and security

- NSA and GCHQ unlock encryption used to protect emails, banking and medical records
- \$250m-a-year US program works covertly with tech companies to insert weaknesses into products
- Security experts say programs 'undermine the fabric of the internet'
