Excerpts from the Election Act of 1 March 1985:

Section 3, first and last paragraphs:

Norwegian nationals who have attained the age of 18 years at the latest during the year in which the election is held and who have not lost the right to vote pursuant to Article 53 of the Constitution are entitled to vote pursuant to this Act. Persons who are not Norwegian nationals are entitled to vote in county and municipal elections provided they have been registered in the Norwegian National Population Register as having resided in the realm for the last three years prior to the election, and they otherwise fulfil the conditions applicable to Norwegian nationals.

Any person who is entitled to vote pursuant to the above provisions must also be registered in the population census on election day in order to be able to exercise the right to vote.

Section 12, second and third paragraphs:

.....

Any person who is entitled to vote in an election and who on election day is registered in the National Population Register as being resident in one of the municipalities of the county and who is not excluded or exempted is eligible for election to the County Council and bound to accept such election.

Any person who is entitled to vote in an election and who on election day is registered in the National Population Register as being resident in the municipality and who is not excluded or exempted is eligible for election to the Municipal Council and bound to accept such election.

If the returning committee sees reason to assume that the voter is suffering from a serious mental debility or is in a reduced state of consciousness, the voter shall not deposit his ballot envelope in the ballot box, but shall give it to the returning committee. The committee shall place the envelope in a special cover, send it, write the voter's name, address and birthdate on the outside, and keep it unopened. A note shall also be made on the cover as to the reason that the ballot envelope has been set aside, and whether the decision to do so was unanimous. Upon conclusion of voting, the returning committee shall deliver the cover to the election committee, which shall decide whether the vote shall be rejected.
